CONTENTS PER WEEK

Week	He	Key contents
1	Before and now	Imperfect tense, generational contrasts, sociohistorical vocabulary
2	Prohibited to prohibit	Impersonality (se + 3rd person), social norms, culture of prohibitions
3	Start over	Temporal periphrases (to take/to begin + gerund), professional CVs
4	Special moments	Imperfect/indefinite contrast, narration of anecdotes
5	Search and compare	Imperative + pronouns, advertising creation, persuasive language

6	Messages	Oral communication strategies (telephone), language games (Taboo)
7	Tomorrow	Imperfect future, hypothesis (perhaps/probably), esoteric consulting room
8	He goes and tells him	OD/OI pronouns (lo/le), oral narrative (jokes/legends), film script
