

- Understand complex texts on abstract and technical topics.
 - Interact fluently in social and professional situations.
 - Prepare detailed texts defending points of view with arguments.
 - Critically analyze information in the media.
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HOW ARE YOU GOING TO LEARN?

Communicative methodology and task-based approach:

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- Dynamic classes with debates, group projects, and critical analysis.
 - Specialized workshops (grammar, conversation).
 - Immersive cultural activities (themed outings).
 - Interactive digital resources (*Campus Diffusion*).
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DURATION AND ORGANIZATION

Intensive courses (20h/week):

- Main class (8h/week): *Aula Plus 6*, 2h/day (Mon-Thurs).
- Mandatory workshops (12h/week):
 - Grammar B2.2 (3 hours): L and Mi.

- Conversation B2.2 (3h): Ma and J.
- Vocabulary (art history) (2h): V.
- Cultural immersion (4h): V.

Extensive course (4h/week):

- Two 2-hour classes per week. Workshop access is subject to availability.

Total hours: 96h (B2.2 complete).

MATERIALS

- Manual: Aula Plus 6 (Diffusion).
- Digital resources: Virtual Campus Dissemination (videos, interactive exercises, updated texts).
- Supplementary material created by teachers.

4. Before it's too late	Environmentalism, textual cohesion, awareness.	Advertising campaign (web or poster).
5. Live to work	Reformulation, examples, work environment.	Design of web sections for companies.
6. Since I didn't know...	Reproaches, past events, education.	Debate on opinion articles and judgments.

ASSESSMENT
